Metairie Savings Bank & Trust Co. opened its first branch with four employees.

The bank's first branch was gutted by a devastating fire but opened with business as usual the next day. They operated out of temporary quarters in the fire-ravaged location until the completion of the new office at 3383 Airline Hwy.

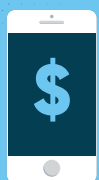
